Dear Colleagues,

Greetings to all our ASAIPA members from this, our first ASAIPA News4u issue of the year – a year that promises to be even more busy for us at ASAIPA and certainly challenging once again for our GP members.

Practice Matters

ASAIPA has already begun working on further representation on behalf of members on key matters of concern to general practice, most notable being the Pharmacy Council application for Pharmacy-Initiated Management of Antiretroviral Therapy (PIMART). We continue to support IPAF's campaigns against this threat to our autonomy as GPs.

Other matters on our table include ongoing engagements with the NDOH, HPCSA, BHF, CMS and other regulatory bodies to best represent the interest of our members. Issues of concern include the Low-Cost Benefit Option Framework proposed by the Council for Medical Schemes (CMS) on which we have submitted comments and concerns.

Importantly, we also await the finalisation of the Constitutional Court directive on the controversial Certificate of Need (CON) legislation, having supported Solidarity's case against the DOH on the matter. On a positive note, we were able to confirm that the Recession Application of the Minister has been postponed sine die, pending the Constitutional Court directive.

ASAIPA members must take note of the many events in which we will be very involved this year; CPD Events, our Charity Golf Day, sponsorship and participation in the GGPF conferences, Roadshows nationally on inpractice issues, and our National Medical Awards (NMA).
