### Minor procedures in rooms

This category includes cover for basic dating scans (performed in the first trimester and limited to the confirmation of pregnancy, its location and gestational age by measurement of crown-rump length or biparietal diameter), routine, minor procedures, in their own rooms, under local (if any) anaesthesia (including finger and toe blocks), eg, injections, excisions, curette cautery, cryocautery, nasal cautery and IUD insertion. It excludes routine provision of acute emergency services like lumbar punctures and nebulisations on the doctor's premises; emergency medicine in a private trauma unit/casualty; diagnostic ultrasound; procedures specifically listed under different GP categories; any form of laser treatment.

### Procedural

This category includes assistance in theatre, basic dating scans (performed in the first trimester and limited to the confirmation of pregnancy, its location and gestational age by measurement of crown-rump length or biparietal diameter), procedures commonly performed by GPs, specifically vasectomies, circumcision, termination of pregnancy; routine emergency care provided in the doctor's rooms, including lumbar puncture and nebulisations; intra-articular injections. It specifically excludes basic pregnancy scans beyond the first trimester and detailed pregnancy scans, as well as intra-partum care. Surgeries normally carried out under general/regional anaesthesia and not listed above (e.g. tonsillectomy, appendectomy) and anaesthetics are excluded.
