AECI Medical Aid Society Family Practitioner Network Scheme rates for 2026

We extend our sincere appreciation for the professional care you have provided to our members throughout 2025. As a valued participant of the AECI Medical Aid Society Family Practitioner (FP) Network, we are pleased to inform you of a **4.6%** increase in the FP tariff applicable to the **AECI Comprehensive, Comprehensive Select and Value Options** effective 1 January 2026.

As a contracted FP of the AECI Medical Aid Society FP Network, you serve as a Designated Service Provider (DSP) for all AECI Medical Aid Society options. Kindly refer to the updated rates below to ensure accurate claims processing.

Reimbursement Model - Comprehensive and Comprehensive Select Options

The 2026 reimbursement model continues to include an **enhanced consultation fee** based on your REPI² category score, as outlined below:

FP consultation rates (0190 - 0192)	
AECI Medical Aid Society FP Network consultation fee	R529.50
Enhanced consultation fee for REPI ² category 1 FP Network practices	R112.50
Enhanced consultation fee for REPI ² category 2 FP Network practices	R50.70

Important Billing Note:

Please do not manually add the enhanced consultation fee to your AECI Medical Aid Society FP Network consultation fee (**R529.50**). This enhanced fee will be automatically allocated to qualifying practices upon payment of consultations. Your remittance advice will reflect a **code 247** comment for each consultation that qualifies for an enhanced fee. Please note that the enhanced fee amount will not appear on individual claim lines. Instead, the total value of all enhanced fees will be consolidated and displayed as a single amount, marked with code 247 and the description "**Enhanced Fees**", at the beginning of the claim summary.

Example:

50 (consultations) X R112.50 (enhanced fee) = R5 625.00



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Reimbursement Model - Value Option

Practitioners are reimbursed based on their dispensing status. Those with a dispensing license receive a higher consultation fee, which includes the cost of any medication provided during the visit. As such, dispensing practitioners should not issue prescriptions for members to collect medication from a pharmacy, as these claims will be declined.

We will reimburse you for performing certain procedures in your rooms instead of referring patients to a hospital for these interventions. The following procedures may be billed **in addition to consultation codes**, with material costs included:

FPs may obtain specialist referrals through the Healthcare Professional (HCP) Portal on the Medscheme website by following these steps:

- Navigate to **Main Menu > My Patients > Specialist Referral**.
- Enter the membership number and select the appropriate **Beneficiary**.
- If the specialist’s practice number is known, enter it and select the preferred specialist from the map.
- If the specialist practice number is unknown, select the relevant discipline, define the preferred search radius, click **Search** and choose the preferred specialist from the map.
