Fedhealth myFED General Practitioner Network Rates for 2026

Fedhealth extends its sincere appreciation for the dedicated care you have provided to our myFED members throughout 2025. As a valued member of the **Fedhealth myFED General Practitioner (GP) Network**, we are pleased to inform you of a **3.1%** increase in the GP tariff effective **1 January 2026**.

As a contracted provider within the **Fedhealth myFED GP Network**, your reimbursement is determined by your dispensing status. GPs with a dispensing license receive a higher consultation fee, which includes the cost of the medication dispensed during the visit. Accordingly, dispensing GPs are expected to provide medication directly to members and should not issue prescriptions for pharmacy collection, as such claims will be rejected.

Coordination of Care (GP Nomination)

Fedhealth strongly advocates for coordinated care with the General Practitioner (GP) playing a central role in this approach. Fragmented healthcare delivery has led to inefficiencies and increased costs for our members. We believe that GP- led care coordination enhances the quality of healthcare and contributes to more sustainable outcomes.

To sustain this model, myFED beneficiaries are encouraged to nominate their treating network GP to oversee and coordinate their care. This nomination can be made by contacting the Fedhealth Customer Contact Centre on **0860 002 153**.

Please note:

- A nominated GP may only be changed once every six months.
- Beneficiaries are entitled to two (2) 'out-of-nomination' GP visits per beneficiary per annum, should they need to consult a GP other than their nominated provider.

Specialist Network and Referral Protocol

Fedhealth would like to remind you of the Fedhealth Specialist Network, comprising of specialists who have committed to billing at the Fedhealth rate. As a result, members will not incur co-payments when consulting these network specialists.

To ensure appropriate and coordinated care, all Fedhealth beneficiaries are required to consult their nominated network GP **prior** to scheduling a specialist appointment. This process enables the GP to assess the patient's needs and refer them to the most suitable specialist for the required level of care.

- Navigate to the **HCPs** tab and log in using your **provider credentials**
- Navigate to **Main Menu > My Patients > Specialist Referral**
- Enter the membership number and select the appropriate **Beneficiary**
- If the specialist's practice number is known, enter it and select the preferred specialist from the map
- If the specialist practice number is unknown, select the relevant discipline, define the preferred search radius, click **Search** and choose the preferred specialist from the map

Day Clinic Network

Effective 1 January 2026, a co-payment of R2 710.00 will apply to members who utilise a **non-network day clinic**. To view the most up-to-date list of network day clinics, please visit the Healthcare Professional (HCP) Portal at www.medscheme.com:

Hospital Network

Members on the my**FED** option may only be admitted to a network hospital. Voluntary use of a non-network hospital will result in a member co-payment. Members on the my**FED** option must also obtain pre-authorisation for any hospitalisation (except for emergencies) in the respective network to avoid a co-payment.
